said code, an order should be passed establishing the procedure to be followed in said election, and designating the voting place for said election.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS:

That all independent candidates at the election to be held on the first Saturday in April, 1970, for the above mentioned offices file their applications to become candidates with the Mayor of this City at The City Hall or or before 30 days before the date of said election:

That all of said applications shall be substantially in the following form:

To the Mayor of the City of Tatum, Texas:

I hereby request that my name be placed upon the official ballot for the election to be held on the 4th day of April, 1970, as a candidate for \_\_\_\_\_ of said City. Thereby certify that I am a citizen of the United States of America and that I am eligible to hold office under the Constitution of this state and have resided in this state for a period of twelve months next preceding the date of said election and have resided in this City in which I offer myself as a candidate for Six months next preceding the date of said election.

All candidates shall file with said application the loyalty affidavit required by Article 6.02 of the Election Code.

That the Secretary of this City shall, in accordance with the terms and provisions of Article 13.32 of the Election Code, post in his office the names of all candidates who have filed their applications in accordance with the terms and provisions of this order, and said names shall be posted at a conspicuous place in said office for at least 10 days before said Secretary orders the same to be printed on the ballot for said election.


The City Secretary is hereby authorized and instructed to provide and furnish all necessary election supplies to conduct said election.

The order in which the names of the candidates are to be printed on the ballot shall be determined by a drawing by the City Secretary as provided by Article 6.05c, Subd.3.

The Mayor shall give notice of this election in accordance with the terms and provisions of Article 4.05 of the Election Code and returns of said notice shall be made as provided in said Article 4.05 and the Mayor shall issue all necessary orders and writs for said election and returns of said election shall be made to the Commissioners immediately after the closing of the polls.

It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body the Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located in the City Hall, a place convenient to the public, and said notice having so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least three days preceding the date of this meeting. A copy of the return of said posting shall be attached to the minutes of this meeting and shall be made a part thereof for all intents and purposes.

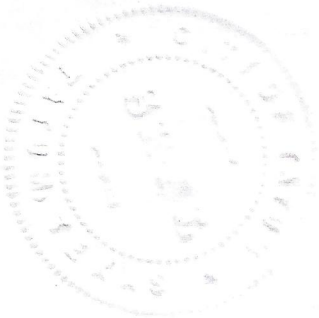
