RESOLUTION AND ORDER CANVASSING RETURNS AND  
DECLARING RESULTS OF SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN  
THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS, ON OCTOBER 10, 1969,  
ON THE QUESTION OF ADOPTION OF A ONE PERCENT  
(1%) LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, there was held in the City of Tatum, Texas, on the 10th day of October, 1969, an election at which there were submitted to the duly qualified resident electors of said City, for their action thereupon, the following propositions:

FOR adoption of a one percent (1%) local sales and use tax within the city.

AGAINST adoption of a one percent (1%) local sales and use tax within the city.

and

WHEREAS, there were cast at said election 136 votes, of which number there were cast:

FOR adoption of a one percent (1%) local sales and use tax within the city. 54 votes

AGAINST adoption of a one percent (1%) local sales and use tax within the city. 82 votes

Majority AGAINST adoption of a one percent (1%) local sales and use tax within the city. 28 votes

as shown in the official election returns heretofore lawfully submitted to the City Commission of the City of Tatum, Texas, and filed with the City Secretary of said City; and

WHEREAS, only duly qualified resident electors of said City voted at said election, and said election was called and held in strict conformity with the laws of the State of Texas: now therefore BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the election described in the preamble to this resolution and order was duly called and notice thereof given in accordance with law; that said election was held in the manner required by law; that only duly qualified resident electors of the City of Tatum, Texas voted at said election; that due returns of said election have been made by the proper officers; that said election resulted unfavorably to the proposition:

FOR ADOPTION OF A ONE PERCENT (1%) LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY: and that a majority of the qualified voters of said City of Tatum, Texas, voting at said election, have voted against the adoption of a One Percent (1%) Local Sales and Use Tax within said City.


Section 2. That the City Commission of the City of Tatum, Texas, hereby officially and affirmatively declares that said One Percent (1%) Local Sales and Use Tax within said City has been properly and lawfully rejected in accordance with the provisions of Article 1066c, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes (Acts 1967, 60th Legislature, Regular Session, Chapter 36, Page 62).

Section 3. That the City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to transmit to the Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas, in Austin, Texas, by United States Registered Mail, or by United States Certified Mail, a certified copy of this Resolution and Order Canvassing the Returns of Special Election, under the official seal of the said City of Tatum, Texas, showing the disapproval of said Local Sales and Use Tax by the qualified voters of said City together with a map of said City, clearly showing the boundaries thereof as of the date of said election.
